Eyexcel – Expanding Global Eye Care Workforce through Excellence in Training

- When? : July 11 – 14, 2017
- Objective of the course : This course provides an opportunity for eye care institutions to develop Ophthalmic Assistant Training Programmes based on the principles of Training Design. The course comprehensively covers all aspects of training: training design, training administration, sharing available training resources, using technology in training and making the training sustainable. This course prepares eye hospital teams to deliver high-quality training on a regular basis for mid-level ophthalmic personnel.
- Who should attend? : Each hospital should bring a team of two to three participants: representing the head of the institute, the person in charge of the training programme, and one person actively involved in delivering the training.

Management Training and Systems Development for Hospital Administrators

- When? : August 10 – September 09, 2017
